



POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

HOW TO ENTER

- Step one: Entrants, create your masterpiece on the blank poster provided for this competition (feel free to photocopy should more copies be required or download from our website, chmfestival.com.au). Entrants do not have to be A4 – feel free to enlarge for the littlies who might need a bit more room.
- Step two: Take a copy of your creation for the scrapbook
- Step three: Bring your original work of art to the Central Highlands Multicultural Festival on Saturday 27 August, Emerald Showgrounds to the Poster Design Competition marquee by no later than 6:00pm. *If you are unable to attend on the night (poor you!), then send completed masterpieces to Central Highlands Development Corporation, PO Box 1425, Emerald Qld 4720 or hand deliver to CHDC, 31 Ruby Street, Emerald*
- Step four: Stop by the Poster Design Competition marquee to admire the awesome job you have done and check out all of the other amazing entries
- Step five: Hang around for presentations at 7:00pm – you could win some fantastic prizes!

ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS

Young artists will be eligible to enter the poster design competition providing all of the following criteria are met and conditions agreed to:

- entrants are between the age of 0-13
- the age group categories are 0-4 years; 5-8 years and 9-13 years and you may enter in only one age category
- entrants are the sole contributor to the poster they design
- entrants can enter as many times as they like - the Poster Design Competition entry form may be photocopied for additional entries. Alternatively, you can download extra copies from the festival website: www.chmfestival.com.au
- pencils are down and posters are in by 6:00pm on Saturday 27 August 2016 – we can't accept responsibility for late or lost entries
- entrants artwork will be on display at this year's festival for all to admire
- you have taken a copy of your entry as unfortunately we cannot return them
- winners will be announced at the Central Highlands Multicultural Festival at approximately 7:00pm – if winners are not present, we will contact the school, playgroup, etc listed – if you do not attend school, playgroup, etc, just pop a parental/legal guardian/caregiver contact phone number on the form

- Interesting and beautiful colours, but if you only have a grey pencil or a dodgy blue biro, then that's cool as well!
- Try to stay in the lines – or don't – it's up to you!
- Mixed media – use pens, pencils, crayon, paint, glitter, tomato sauce, mums old magazines – pretty much anything you can get your hands on
